## **Typical Winter Camping Pack List**

(this is for car camping not backpacking)

\*Note: put everything in one water resistant duffle bag or your backpack

### **Clothing**

- Boots (preferably two pairs, one pair insulated, one pair hiking)
- Socks (preferably NO cotton) one more pair than the nights sleeping
- Long underpants (NO cotton) (preferably polypropylene, wool, fleece, etc.)
- Underpants (preferably briefs)
- Pants
- Nylon shell and/or snow pants
- Belt
- Undershirts (preferably NOT cotton) (polypropylene is excellent)
- Long sleeve overshirts (preferably NOT cotton) (wool, fleece, or polypropylene are best)
- Winter jacket
- Gloves
- Hat (NOT cotton) (wool, fleece, or polypropylene are best)

### **Sleeping gear**

- Sleeping bag (properly rated)
- Sleeping pad (if preferred)
- Tent (if sleeping outside) (preferably a four season tent without fiberglass poles)

### **Cooking/serving/eating gear (if NOT supplied by Patrol)**

- Cooking stove and fuel
- Cooking pans/pots (to support planned menu) (
- Cooking/serving utensils (to support planned menu)
- Eating place ware/utensils (plates, bowls, cups, cutlery to support planned menu)
- Cleaning basin/bowl, dish soap, scouring pad, towel

### **Supplies/consumables**

- Food (if NOT supplied by Patrol)
- Toilet paper

### **Misc.**

- Toiletries (comb, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
- Towel and soap (if staying long enough to shower or facilities are available)
- Pocketknife
- Water bottle
- Personal first aid kit
- Boy Scout handbook
- Compass or GPS device
- Headlamp
- Watch (preferably water resistant)

### **Patrol gear:**

- Patrol flag & first aid kit
- Portable food cooler
- Cooking stove, fuel, gear (if cooking as a Patrol)
